The evening will be all about the look, the makeup, the costume, the stagecraft and the performance. It will be an electric kaleidoscope of colour from every angle.

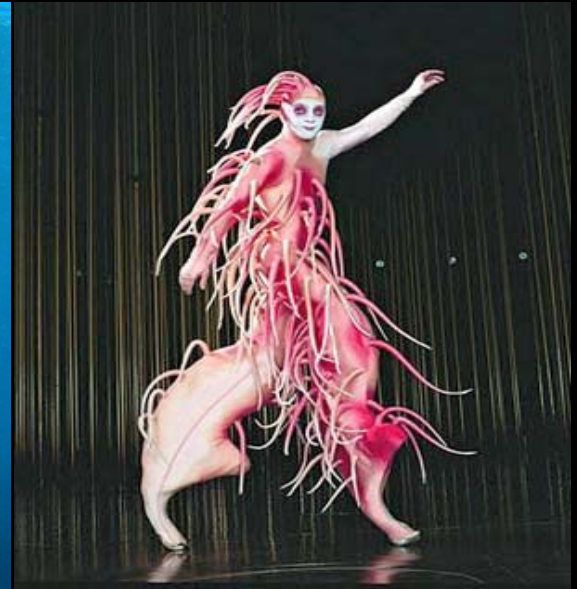
We will also collaborate with the producer of the year nominee Mark Ralph to create poignant musical moments through out the night. Think the Heritage Orchestra featuring Clean Bandit doing a version of 'Starman' at the stroke of midnight or Olly from Years and Years singing a deep house version of 'Lets Dance' in the disco. Each magical performance will be carefully orchestrated and devised to showcase the best artistry the UK has to offer.





THE CHARACTERS

We will work with the National Circus School which we have good ties with to put together a team of skilled circus performers. We'll have an array of risk taking and exhilarating performances through out the building.

From ariel and trapeze artists on the roof to super human skills being performed on the 5th. We'll collate an unrivalled mix of genuine circus talent from around the world to dazzle and entertain our Shoreditch members.

Every character will have a role and a purpose, from magicians serving drinks, to waitresses conducting juggling performances or erotic dancing whilst waiting tables.

Where ever you eye will wonder you will be tantalized and entertained.



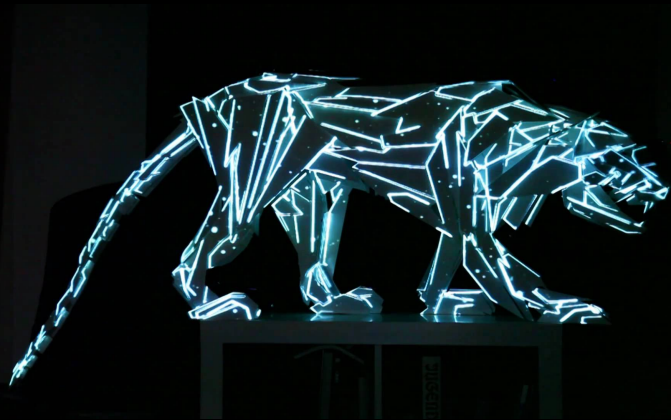
STAGE CRAFT

Jack will use a mix of mediums to create a visually arrestive and immersive circus experience, including the latest video mapping technology and bespoke art installations including light works and inflatable structures.

- The entrance of the building will be turned into a clowns mouth which members will have to walk through the mouth to enter.
- On the 5th floor we'll turn the Tennis Room into a circus themed house of mirrors.
- The lazy garden will turned into a star and moon gazing garden with trampoline artists performing an unique video mapping and neon light performance.
- The pool will be come a video mapping art canvas. The entire pool will be filled with 50,000 ping pong balls which will then be video mapped with mind blowing graphics.
- At the stroke of 12 a Starman themed firework display will ensue in unison with our synchronized dancers who will be perform a special choreographed dance in our video mapped pool.









THE MUSIC

We like to keep things in the family so we've enlisted the services of Mark Ralph as our musical director to help produce our big musical moments. Nominated this year by the A&R awards for producer of year, Mark is one of the UK's most sought after producers, producing albums for the likes of Clean Bandit, Years and Years, Rudimental, Blonde, Aluna George, Kygo, Hot Chip, Pete Tong and the Heritage Orchestra.

We want to create 4 to 5 "Wow, can you believe it musical moments". Mark will produce and create these productions, be it a live performance or a unique remix or a breathtaking live PA.

A huge fan of Bowie Mark will work with some of his recent artist and his management company Machine Management to secure and produce unique once in a lifetime performances from some of the UK's finest musicians.
